Brothers in Nakuro, kenya, for a new kitchen.

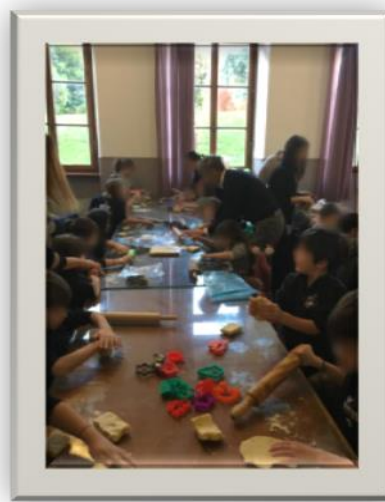
**Class 3** decorated the primary school Christmas tree with middle school. Together they made Christmas crafts to decorate it.
